



## Scoil Mobhí

### Éide Scoile

Bríste nó sciorta liath

Léine nó blús gorm

Stocáí nó riteoga bána, dubha nó liath

Bróga nó buataisí dubha (níl cead buataisí boga) nó bróga reatha dubha/bána

Geansaí fíondaite le líne gorm ag an imeall mhuiníl píceach

Seaicéad Scoil Mobhí (roghnach)

**San aimsir te** tá cead ag na páistí léine gorm le muinchillí gairid a chaitheamh agus bríste gairid liath.

### Éide chorpoideachais

Bróga bonnrubair – nach bhfágann marc ar an úrlár agus gan Velcro nó iallacha

Bríste liath dorcha de chulaith raon (gan aon ‘logo’)

Bíodh gruaig do pháiste ceangailte siar.

**Mála scoile** mór go leor do leabhair 30 cm<sup>2</sup>

Ní ceadáítear ‘hoodies’.

Ceadáítear t-léinte dubh, dubhgorm, liath nó bán faoi na héadaí scoile.

**Ba chóir go mbeadh ainm an linbh ar ghach a bhaineann leo.**

## Scoil Mobhí

### **Uniform**

Grey trousers or skirt

Light blue shirt or blouse

white, black or grey socks or tights (girls)

Black shoes or boots (soft boots not permitted) or black/white runners

wine jumper with a blue stripe at the v-neck line

Scoil Mobhí jacket (optional)

**In hot weather** the children may wear short-sleeved blue shirts or blouses and grey shorts.

### **P.E. Uniform**

Plimsolls which do not mark the floor and without Velcro or laces.

Dark grey tracksuit trousers (no logos)

Please ensure your child's hair is tied back

**School bags** big enough to carry books of 30 cm<sup>2</sup>

Hoodies are not permitted.

Black, navy, grey or white clothing permitted under the school uniform.

**The child's name should be on everything that belongs to him/her.**
